

Little Miss Boone County Fair

Rules and Eligibility:

- Boone county resident
- 6-8 years of age
(Cannot turn 9 before June 1st 2010)
- U.S. citizen
- Anyone who has held the title of Little Miss Boone Co will not be eligible to participate in the future.
- Contestants agree to the following:
 - Abide by all the rules of the pageant
 - Attend all rehearsals and interviews
 - Be interviewed by the judges
 - Appear in a conservative summer dress for judging
 - Appear in a party dress on stage
 - Present a 30 second rehearsed speech on stage
 - Demonstrate good sportsmanship throughout and after the competition
 - The decision of the judges is final and scoring is kept confidential
 - Contestants will represent the Boone Co. Fair at various local functions unless academics make it impossible.
 - Appearances of any kind made wearing the Little Miss Boone Co. Fair Queen sash and crown must have the consent of the Pageant Director and must be chaperoned by pageant staff.
 - While wearing the Sash and crown, you will not chew gum and will dress and act in a respectable manner.
 - If you cannot fulfill the expressed duties, violate any rule set forth, or conduct yourself in a manner unbecoming of a queen and representative of the Boone County Fair, you will immediately relinquish your title, crown, sash, and all prizes upon the direction of the Boone Co. Fair Pageant Director. The 1st runner up will then be eligible for the title.

Sunday before the fair girls will come to the community building and practice with the queen contestants in the morning.

Sunday night at the preview little miss will wear a conservative summer dress. She will be interviewed by the judges in the afternoon and have an on stage interview while the queens are changing their clothes.

Tuesday while queens change their clothes between swimsuits and evening gowns, the little miss will introduce themselves, in their party dress and give their 30-second prepared speech "What I Want to be When I Grow Up".

The little miss will be crowned after the top 3 queens are announced.

During the fair Little Miss will spend the daytime with the queen and announce the evening show and then go home. Or go home in the afternoon for a nap and return for the evening show.

Judging:

Interview: 0-25 points

Prepared Speech: 0-25 points

Poise: 0-25 points

Enthusiasm: 0-25 points

Total 100 points

Personal Interview: This will take place with the judges and on the stage at the community building. They will answer questions prepared by the judges. Contestants are required to wear a summer dress and socks with their shoes.

Speech and communication skills: This will be judged when the contestants deliver their 30 second rehearsed speeches on the subject of "What I Want to be When I Grow Up" Contestants will wear their party dress for this portion.
