Non-Livestock/Home Economics bldg. will be closed all day Tuesday. Starting on Wednesday the building will be open daily from 10:00 am to 8:30 pm.

Premium checks and exhibits can be picked up in department on Sunday, starting at 3:00 pm until 6:00 pm for both checks and exhibits.

A line will form at the Dept. O counter by the wedding cakes so department personnel can assist each exhibitor during the checkout process.

DUE TO HEALTH HAZARDS—ALL FOODS OTHER THAN CANNED GOODS WILL NOT BE RETURNED.

NO FROSTING UNLESS STATED IN INDIVIDUAL CLASS.

Exhibitors are requested to use Standard Mason, Kerr or Ball-type Jars and lids. **All jars must have lids on, rusty lids will be disqualified.** Foods must have been canned within a year, and processing date noted on lid. No additional adornments or decorations on jars or lids unless in the Collection Categories. If Judges find it necessary, jars may be opened to sample. Canned goods should be brought in without the rings. Can rings can be put back on anytime after Wednesday.

All bakery goods must be homemade by exhibitor. All bakery goods including small loaves of bread and pies need to be brought in on 6-7 inch paper plates in clear ziploc-type bags. No Saran wrap or twist tie type bags.

We are not responsible for lost, stolen or broken items.

Exhibitor tickets must be purchased at the time entries are made. If not purchased, exhibitor will have to pay a gate fee on Sunday to come in and pick up your check and your entries, otherwise the building will be opened by the secretary on Monday, August 11th from 5:00 pm to 7:00 pm ONLY.
