The Boone County Fair Barrow Show is a NON-terminal show.

Open Show exhibitors will be allowed to take animals home or send to market.

The Fair Board will have trucks available and will supervise loading for barrows going to slaughter.

PUREBRED BARROWS MUST BE REGISTERED IN THE EXHIBITORS NAME.

Mailed entries must be postmarked before midnight Saturday, July 12th

Entries can be made in person and will be taken in the Administration Bldg. on the fairgrounds which will be open on

Saturday, July 19th, 9:00 am to 5:00 pm, and Sunday July 20th, 9:00 am to 5:00 pm ONLY.

Only Bag Shavings allowed for bedding!

No washing pigs during Judging. We need the pens for holding pens during the show.

NO TACK PENS ALLOWED. All tack must be above pens.

Premise ID is REQUIRED for exhibition at all 2025 County, State, 4-H and FFA fairs in Illinois and must appear on the entry form

Premium checks will be HELD until PENS ARE CLEANED, when they are cleaned then checks will be available in the

Swine Barn on Sunday, August 10th from 12:00 noon to 3:00 pm

Exhibitors who change the location of their tagged pens without permission from the

swine superintendent may have their premiums withheld.

No animal with evidence of arthritis will be allowed to show. An official certification of weight of each barrow shown must be secured from the official weighmaster before show. The first weight is the final weight. INDIVIDUAL BARROWS MUST WEIGH BETWEEN 230 AND 290 POUNDS. ALL CLASSES MUST HAVE AT LEAST FIVE ENTRIES OR THEY WILL BE COMBINED WITH AN-OTHER CLASS. LIMIT OF TWO PREMIUMS PER EXHIBITOR PER CLASS. THERE WILL BE A MAXIMUM OF FIVE CLASSES IN THE PUREBRED, AND A MAXIMUM OF SIX CLASSES IN THE CROSSBREEDS.

ALL SWINE EXHIBITED AT ILLINOIS COUNTY FAIRS WILL **BE REQUIRED TO HAVE AN ELECTRONIC 840 TAG.**

All livestock exhibitor's trucks, trailers and vehicles must be parked outside the gates. Swine Market and Trucking Designation Forms must be completed and returned to Rob Goeddeke by 8 PM Wednesday, August 6th.

PENS MUST BE CLEANED EACH DAY BY 8:00 A.M.

All swine exhibitors will need to obtain the appropriate certification: Adults: valid Adult PQA certification, Youth (ages 8-21) as of Sept. 1, 2024: Youth Quality Care of Animals (YQCA) certification or valid Youth PQA, Youth 7 years and under will fall under a parent/guardian's Adult PQA.

The Illinois Dept. of Agriculture strictly forbids the use of Paylean

or the generic form Ractopamine in show hogs. The BCFA abides by this rule and any animal testing positive for Paylean or Ractopamine will be the sole responsibility of the exhibitor and punishment could include the exhibitor suspension of show privilage at subsequent Boone County Fair Swine shows.

BCFA reserves the right to test any animal being exhibited for the presence of illegal drugs or banned substances. Failure of any testing procedures will result in the exhibitor forfeiting premiums and the exhibitor will be suspended 1 year & 1 day for 1st Offense and permanently banned for 2nd Offense. BCFA will cover cost of testing.

The following grooming practices are prohibited in the Open & Junior Swine Show: a) The use of any substance to alter or enhance the color of animals, including hide and hooves. b) The use of any substance, material or product to build, change or alter the shape or conformation of animals. c) The use of any substances of augmentations that adversely affect a carcasses ability to enter the food chain may result in disgualification at the discretion of the superintendent and General Livestock Superintendent. d) Animals may be subject to a white or black towel test as they enter the show ring. Detection of substances to alter or enhance animals will result in disgualification of the animals.
